1. Jesus was born in the genealogical line of Abraham and King David. 1:1-17
2. Mary is with child by the Holy Spirit 1:18
3. Angels foretold the birth of Jesus, warned of the danger to the child Jesus posed by King Herod, and told Joseph of the proper time to return to Israel with Jesus. 1:20-21; 2:13, 19-20
4. Magi from the east recognize Jesus as the king of the Jews and come to Bethlehem to give him gifts of gold, incense and myrrh. 2:1-12
5. A voice from heaven affirms that Jesus is the Son of God and affirms God's love for him while Jesus is being baptized by John at the Jordan river to fulfill all righteousness. 3:16
6. Peter confesses that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. 16:13-20
7. Jesus appears with Moses and Elijah and a voice from a cloud declares: "This is my Son, whom I love; with whom I am well pleased." 17:5
8. Jesus dies on the cross and following an earthquake, a centurion guarding Jesus said that he was the Son of God. 27:45:54

d. Jesus is a shepherd who has compassion on Israel.

1. In the region of Tyre and Sidon Jesus, who stated that he was sent only to the lost sheep of Israel, is persuaded to help a Canaanite woman because of her great faith. 15:21-28
2. Jesus declares "O Jerusalem, ...how often I have longed to gather your children...but you were not willing." 23: 37
3. Jesus preaches the good news of the kingdom and heal the sick and he has compassion on the people because they are harassed and helpless. 9:35-36
4. Jesus calls all who are weary to come to him and find rest. 11:28
5. Jesus blesses five loaves and two fish and feeds five thousand men besides women and children. 14:13-21
6. Jesus is a healer. 8:17, 9:2-8, 9:21-22, 9:25,30,33; 12:15; 14:36, 15:28,30

- a. When Jesus came down from the mountain, he healed a man with leprosy, a servant of a Centurion, Peter's mother-in-law, and many others. 8:1-14
